Here are some rules and procedures that will help the class run smoothly:

1. Respect and cooperation is the most important part of class.
2. You must be **on time** every day for class and in **full uniform**. When the bell rings, you are in your seat ready to begin class.
3. Please use the restrooms and sharpen pencils before the beginning of class. Bathroom passes can be found in the front of the room. One boy and girl at a time.
4. You must bring a, pen, notebook, folder, and textbook to class each day unless instructed otherwise. Notebooks will be organized into sections and may be checked for a grade. Folders should be neat. Homework points will be deducted if these are not followed.
5. You will be given a Do Now every day. This must be completed during the beginning of class. Homework will be checked at this time.
6. Homework is given and checked daily. You will start off with a 100 %. At the end of the trimester, this grade will be averaged in with the quiz grades.
7. If you do not complete your homework on the day it is due, five points are deducted. If completed the day after, points are rewarded back.
8. If you are absent, you should make up your work in a timely fashion. (General rule: one day for each day of absence). If you are absent for a test, it must be made up within the week. Please see me to discuss the arrangements. YOU are responsible to obtain missed work.
9. Quizzes will be announced a few days ahead. They will be based on material covered in class or homework. It is best to review your notes on a regular basis to be prepared.
10. Tests will be announced about a week ahead of time. They will be approximately every 2 weeks. They will be based on discussions/notes, vocabulary, worksheets, homework, quizzes, and textbook pages. In class review often occurs the day before the test.
11. Labs will be conducted at my discretion and depending on allotted time. You will be asked to complete work with the lab and hand it in according to the due date.
12. When handing in work or signed tests (that are 70% and below), you will place it in the bin that has your appropriate period on the side. If it is not placed in the bin, you will not get credit. YOU are responsible to get work signed if needed.
13. Extra help is available. Come see me to discuss a time.
14. Projects will be forthcoming.
15. All rules stated in the handbook will be strictly enforced in class.
